Parijat Urja Chakra has adopted 4 villages and farmers thereof for improving agricultural income by improvement of agricultural practices. Approximately 100 farmers are adopted. A team of very senior Agricultural experts headed by the Ex Director of Horticulture in Haryana has been contracted for this project. Resources have been allocated in terms of classroom training, farmer field, establishing demonstration farms, soil testing, providing of agricultural inputs and advanced agricultural techniques are the comprehensive package of this initiative.
